Recommended routes



Valsaín Mountain Route

A circular ride through La Granja, the pine forests of Valsaín and the Navacerrada mountain pass. Ideal for touring and trail bikes. Approx. distance: 45–60 km

Eresma Valley Route

From Palazuelos to Tizneros and Santo Domingo de Pirón along quiet secondary roads. Gentle curves and rural landscapes. Approx. distance: 40 km

La Granja – Turégano Route

One of the most popular routes, combining paved roads and easy trails. Includes stops in Brieva and Torreiglesias. Approx. distance: 120–130 km

Route of the Royal Sites

La Granja - Riofrío - Revenga - Valsaín - return. A scenic route rich in history and natural beauty. Approx. distance: 35 km

Segovia Castles Route

La Granja - Segovia - Pedraza - Turégano. Perfect for a half-day ride, including a stop at Castilnovo Castle. Approx. distance: 110 km

Extended routes

N-110 Route to Ávila

A classic and popular road with excellent surface and wide bends. Passes through Torrecaballeros and Villacastín before reaching Ávila. Approx. distance: 65–160 km (depending on route)

Red & Black Villages Route

A longer, more scenic journey through the Sierra de Ayllón. Discover traditional villages known for their distinctive architecture. Notable stops: Madriguera, El Muyo, Villacorta, Alquité, Serracín, Becerril. Approx. distance: 170 km

Additional suggested routes

Duratón River

Route Valsaín - Sepúlveda - Carrascal del Río - Pedraza. Includes the stunning San Frutos viewpoint and the Hoces del Duratón Natural Park. Approx. distance: 205–300 km

Mountain Pass Route (Madrid–Segovia)

A circular route crossing four mountain passes between 1,500 and 2,000 metres above sea level. Madrid - Navacerrada - La Granja - Navafría - Canencia - Morcuera - return. Approx. distance: 200 km

'7 Revueltas' Route

La Granja - Navacerrada (CL-601). Famous for its tight 180° hairpin bends—an iconic stretch for motorcyclists. Approx. distance: 20–25 km
