The Camino de Madrid is a historic pilgrimage route that connects the Spanish capital with the French Way in Sahagún (León), covering approximately 320 kilometres through Castilian landscapes rich in history and character. Along the way, modern pilgrims encounter centuries-old traditions in a peaceful and authentic setting.

You can begin your Camino directly from our hotel or, if you are already on your journey, find here the perfect place to rest and recharge. Before continuing towards Sahagún, give your body and mind the rest they deserve.

## The route through Segovia

This section of the Camino starts in Madrid and crosses the Sierra de Guadarrama before reaching Segovia, one of the most iconic stops along the route. Pilgrims can admire its Roman aqueduct, the Alcázar and the cathedral before continuing their journey.

## Suggested itinerary

Madrid – Tres Cantos (28 km)  
Tres Cantos – Manzanares el Real (31 km)  
Manzanares el Real – Segovia (52 km, often divided into two days)  
From Segovia, the route continues towards Valladolid and finally Sahagún.

A combination of urban sections and natural trails through pine and oak forests. Less crowded than the French Way, it offers a more, authentic and reflective experience.
